2012 CITY OF CHASKA GENERAL ELECTION LOCAL RESULTS

The voting is over and the results are in! With a population of approximately 24,000 residents, Chaska's overall voter turnout of the entire population was approximately 55.58%. The percentage of registered voter turnout averaged 69%. New registrations made up an average of 17% of election-day activity.

Wards 1 and 2 utilized new polling sites at the Moravian Church and Christ Victorious Church respectively. Overall, the sites worked well, offering more square footage and additional parking. On average, 16 election judges and one City liaison employee staffed each site. The judges all began their day at 6:00 am and most finished up between 11:00 pm and midnight. They all did an excellent job of maintaining crowd control, deciphering whether residents were at the correct polling place, and getting voters through the voting process. There were only a few minor glitches, which were quickly remedied.

The City of Chaska would like to thank all the people who assisted in making the 2012 General Election flow smoothly, and also the residents who showed patience and may have had to wait in line during the busiest times of the day. Below are the result statistics, which will be canvassed by the Chaska City Council on November 13th.
