POOL UPDATE

Over the past two weeks, work has been moving along very well on the capital improvements being made to the pool area at the Community Center. The mechanical improvements have been completed and patrons will notice locker room improvements being made this week. Another update Community Center patrons will notice is the replacement of the pool deck surface. Colored epoxy has been used on the deck to make it more attractive, as well as easier to clean and maintain. All this work is scheduled to be completed by the end of May.

The City is also working to replace food service in the Northern Lights Café, which closed at the beginning of the month. New food options are scheduled to be available when the pool re-opens in the beginning of June.

The pool deck will have a complete renovation.
