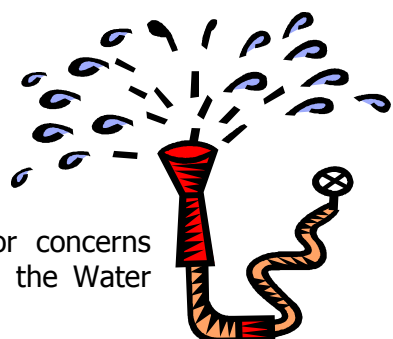

City of Chaska Enforcing Odd-Even Watering Restrictions

As part of the State Mandated Water Conservation Plan and in order to insure adequate water supply for water protection, the Chaska Water Department has implemented an odd-even lawn-watering program. This program greatly reduces the City's peak water demand during the heavy usage months between May 1st and September 30th.

The City of Chaska Water Department is requesting residents to comply with this program. You are required to limit your lawn sprinkling and other non-essential water use based on your address and the calendar day of the month. If your address is an odd number, you must limit your lawn sprinkling to odd number calendar days. Likewise, your neighbor with an even numbered address must limit their lawn sprinkling to even number days.

COMPLIANCE WITH THIS ORDINANCE IS MANDATORY. Failure to comply may result in a \$100 fine and/or termination of water service. Un-established new seed or sod is exempt from this ordinance for a 14-day period. Thank you for your cooperation! 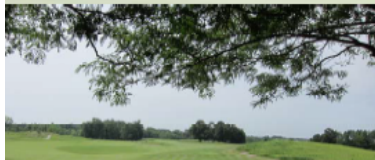
