CHASKA WELCOMES KIDS BACK TO SCHOOL

The City of Chaska would like to take this opportunity to welcome all students in the community back to school and wishes all them a successful school year. With the new school year, two new schools have opened in the City.

The first one is the relocation of Southwest Christian High School to their new building at 1981 Bavaria Road. For the past ten years SW Christian has been located in one of the old NordicTrack buildings on Peavey Road. The City of Chaska is excited to have this new high school building in the community and we wish them success as they move forward. For residents who are interested in seeing the new school, an open house will be held on Saturday, September 29th from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm. A dedication ceremony and ribbon cutting will be held from 10:30 am to 11:00 am. The other new school building in the community is the Jonathan Montessori School, which previously shared facilities with the World Learner School at the intersection of Hundertmark and Village Roads. Jonathan Montessori purchased the St. Andrew West Church building at the corner of Hundertmark and Bavaria and over the summer they have been making improvements to allow the building to serve as their stand-alone facility. Jonathan Montessori School has always been a great asset to the community and the City of Chaska looks forward to them having an expanded campus adjacent to the World Learner School which will continue the partnership between the schools.

The beginning of the school year also brings fall sports activities. We hope you are able to attend some of the games and extracurricular activities hosted by the schools and show your support of our kids and their teachers. Learn to Skate

Group skating lessons are considered STEP 1 toward becoming any type of skater, including a recreational or competitive figure skater. Chaska Skate School hosts the Basic Skills Program, which is available for beginner to intermediate skaters ages 3 and older and beginner adults. Classes are offered year-round.



Each week, skaters receive group instruction using the ISI Learn to Skate curriculum. All classes are 30 minutes and meet once per week.

Class placement is determined by skill level and age.

**THE EMPLOYMENT SITUATION-JULY
2012**

Total nonfarm payroll employment rose by 163,000 in July, and the unemployment rate was essentially unchanged at 8.3%, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported. Employment rose in professional and business services, food services and drinking places, and manufacturing.



In July, average hourly earnings for all employees on private nonfarm payrolls edged up by 2 cents to \$23.52. Over the year, average hourly earnings rose by 1.7 percent. In July, average hourly earnings of private-sector production and nonsupervisory employees increased by 2 cents to \$19.77.
