## 212 MEDICAL CENTER RECEIVES APPROVAL FOR BUILDING ADDITION

At the August 20<sup>th</sup> Council meeting, approval was given to the final site and building plans for the 212 Ridgeview Medical Center addition at the northeast corner of Highways 212 and 41. The 212 Medical Center opened up just over a year and a half ago. Since that time they have done better than projected. The Center offers a 24-hour emergency room, urgent care, imaging services, and specialty clinics, which have already been utilized by more people than originally anticipated.

With the success of the first phase of the medical center, the developer continues to receive interest from specialty clinics to locate in the facility. To accommodate the demand, Ridgeview has decided to move forward with the second phase of the building, which will be an addition of approximately 70,000 sq ft and three stories in height. The addition will be placed off the northwest corner of the existing building and parallel with Highway 41. As with the first phase of the facility, the new building will have the potential to go to six stories in the future.

The planned addition and the opportunity to house more services will assist the specialty clinics and Ridgeview and Allina already currently located within the building. Groundbreaking is slated to begin this fall. The project is anticipated to take 14-18 months to complete, with an opening date of early 1014.

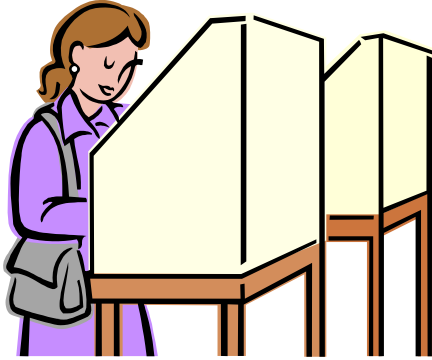

## CHASKA ELECTION NEWS



The Primary Election was held on Tuesday, August 14<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. The City of Chaska did not have any offices on the ballot, as the Mayor and Councilmembers are non-partisan. However, an average of 7.58% of Chaska residents did turn out to vote for Federal, State, and County offices. This was not a huge turn out but it did allow residents and election judges the opportunity to familiarize themselves with new polling places.

When the redistricting process was completed after the 2010 census, Chaska Ward boundaries were realigned at the beginning of the year to accommodate new population growth and keep each Ward approximately the same size. The City went from four Wards, with six Precincts, to just four Wards. The two Precincts in Ward 1 located at City Hall and the Water Treatment Center were combined and moved to the Chaska Moravian Church at 115 East Fourth Street. The two Precincts in Ward 2 located at St. Andrew’s Church and the Clover Field Community Room were combined and moved to Christ Victorious Church at 9860 Shady Oak Road. Wards 3 and 4 remained at New Life Assembly of God Church at 950 Trumble Street and the Chaska Community Center at 1661 Park Ridge Drive, respectively.

With the population of Chaska now approximately 24,000, each Ward contains about 6,000 residents. Of those 6,000 people, about half are registered voters. The following is a breakdown of voter turn out in each Ward. You can see by the statistics how each Ward is very similar in size. Interestingly enough, the smallest Ward had the largest voter turnout.

The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 6<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. Residents who are unable to vote in person that day, may vote by absentee ballot beginning September 21<sup>st</sup> at the Carver County Courthouse until 5:00 pm on Monday, November 5<sup>th</sup>.

The City of Chaska elects a Mayor every two years. Two candidates have filed; incumbent Mark Windschitl, and Richard Swanson. Incumbent Greg Boe is running unopposed for Ward 2, and Jay Rohe is running unopposed for Ward 4, as Rick Ford, the current Councilman for Ward 4, did not file for re-election.
