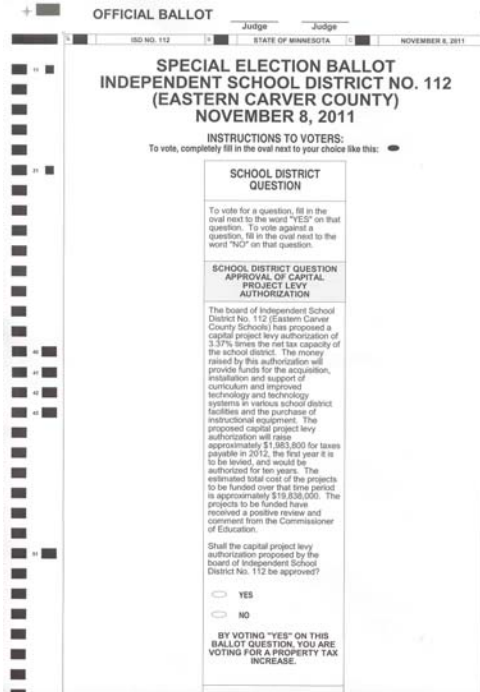

SCHOOL DISTRICT REFERENDUM VOTE



On Tuesday, November 8th School District 112 will hold a Special Election to vote for approval of a Capital Project Levy Authorization, authorizing 3.37% times the net tax capacity of the School District. The money would provide funds for the acquisition, installation, and support of curriculum and improved technology and technology systems in various School District facilities. The proposed capital project levy would raise approximately \$1,983,800 for taxes payable in 2012, the first year it is levied and would be authorized for the next ten years. The estimated total cost of the project over the time period would be \$19,838,000. School District

residents are asked to vote yes or no. The City of Chaska has contracted with the School District to provide polling equipment and training to thirty-three election judges. The polling sites will open at 7:00 am on Tuesday, November 8th and close at 8:00 pm. **Please note: Voters will utilize School District polling sites, not the usual City or Township polling sites.** The following is a list of the 4 polling sites open from 7 am to 8 pm.

- If you live in the City of Chaska or Chaska Township:
Vote at Chaska Middle School West at 140 Engler Boulevard East
- If you live in the City of Chanhassen:
Vote at the Chanhassen Recreation Center at 2310 Coulter Boulevard
- If you live in the City of Victoria or Laketown Township:
Vote at the Victoria City Hall at 7951 Rose Street
- If you live in Carver, Dahlgren Township, or San Francisco Township:
Vote at the East Union Elementary School at 15655 Co Rd 43

UPDATE ON BOUNTIFUL BASKET FOOD SHELF PROJECT

Over the past two weeks a lot of work has occurred to the site of the old water treatment plant building at the corner of Engler and Bavaria Road to prepare for the remodel of the building which will soon house the Bountiful Basket Food Shelf. The parking lot and loading dock area have been graded and will be paved over the next two weeks. Residents will also notice a significant amount of work begin to occur on the building itself. The roof will be placed and interior and mechanical work will be updated. The target date for completion of the project is Christmas. Bountiful Basket hopes to move their operations into the building by the first of January.

The City of Chaska has appreciated the partnership with the CAP Agency and Bountiful Basket to help bring this project to "Fruition." We look forward to a long relationship that meets the needs the community and the organization.
