**SW TRANSIT SHUTTLE TO THE STATE FAIR**

The Great Minnesota Get Together started today and runs through Monday, September 5<sup>th</sup>. A great way to get to and from the fair and avoid the traffic and road construction is by taking the bus. After a long hot day at the fair, you can ride home in air-conditioned comfort and let the bus driver do the work.

Southwest Transit provides service to and from the fair from Wooddale Church on weekdays only, located at 6630 Shady Oak Road, Eden Prairie. Buses run every half hour. On weekends and Labor Day, you can park at the Southwest Station in Eden Prairie or at the Southwest Village Station in Chanhassen, where the buses also run every half hour. These are great locations for Chaska residents, as it is only a short car ride home after you've been at the fair all day eating, and walking, and getting hot and tired. And round trip fare is only \$5.00. (Please have exact change.) Kids age four and under ride free. If you go online you can buy tickets in advance and get four for the price of three.
