### CHASKA TOWN COURSE EVENTS

If you have never golfed Hazeltine National Golf Course or the Chaska Town Course, now is your opportunity! The Chaska Golf Experience will be held on Monday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>. In one special day you can play Hazeltine and the Town Course back to back. The event is limited to 50 foursomes (200 players) and there are still a few slots open. The cost is \$350.00 per player and includes an 18-hole round of golf at each course, with carts, a gourmet box lunch prepared by Charlie's Grille, and great prizes for on-course pin events and contests. The shotgun style event starts at 8:00 am, with the second round beginning at 2:00 pm.

Another event at the Town Course open to all Chaska residents is the Match Play Championship. The entry fee is \$25, with a registration deadline of May 16<sup>th</sup>. This ladder style championship is held throughout the summer. Watch for a special flyer with more details in your City utility bill!

The Women's League Kick Off will be held on April 27<sup>th</sup>, the Men's League Kick off is April 28<sup>th</sup>, and the Two-Man League Kick Off is April 29<sup>th</sup>.
