## CO RD 140 TO CLOSE FOR TWO WEEKS

In preparation for new residential development about to occur in the SW Chaska area, the City of Chaska will be working over the next two weeks to extend sewer up Co Rd 140 (the Cemetery Road). The existing sewer line runs up the center of Co Rd 140 just south of the cemetery. A new sewer line will hook up with the existing line running north approximately 500 feet. Co Rd 140 will be closed from October 28<sup>th</sup> to November 15<sup>th</sup> to accommodate the construction project. During the closure, traffic will be detoured along Co Rds 61 and 11 to give residents access to the existing homes on Co Rd 140 east of the 212 freeway. Detour signs are located at the intersection of Co Rd 61 and Hickory. The project is on track to be completed by November 15<sup>th</sup>.

## MONK NAMED OUTSTANDING CONSERVATIONIST

Bill Monk, the Chaska City Engineer, was recently selected as the 2013 Carver County Outstanding Conservationist. Bill has worked with city leaders to design and implement innovative storm water treatment systems on city-owned properties. One of the first projects he worked on when starting with the

City of Chaska was to restore 20 acres of wetlands, enabling the Chaska Town Course to be created. Close to 40 acres of upland prairie was also restored at that time. He has been a key player in restoring natural vegetation to the Seminary Fen, and he works closely with the Soil and Water Conservation District staff monitoring construction sites for erosion and sediment control measures. **Cold Weather Snow Removal  
Reminder**

As the cold weather sets in, residents are reminded that calendar parking takes effect November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup> in Chaska. During this time parking is allowed on the odd numbered side of the street on odd days and on the even side on even days of the week. Also, parking is not allowed in posted areas of the

downtown business district from 2:00 am to 6:00 am. These rules are in place to help the public works crews most efficiently clear snow so that the roads can be cleared as quickly as possible.

Snow removal begins when it has accumulated to a depth of 2" or more and also after a snowstorm has subsided. Typically, crews are dispatched between 2:00 and 3:00 am if a storm is predicted to last for a long period of time or the snow accumulation is heavy. Snow plowing begins on snow emergency routes first.

If any city equipment damages sod on the right-of-way adjacent to your property, the sod will be repaired in the spring with black dirt and seed. The City does not repair landscaping or structures installed in the right-of-way. Damage to a mailbox by direct contact from city equipment will be repaired or replaced with a standard box as soon as possible. Damage caused by the force of snow coming off a plow blade will not be repaired. Residents are encouraged to check their mailbox posts now to make sure there is no deterioration already taking place that would make them unstable.



It should be noted that it is against City ordinance to shovel, plow, or blow snow into any city streets.
