Pre-sale tickets will not be available after 9:00 am on Friday, November 15th. Ticket prices are \$8 (students: K-12) and \$12 (adults). Tickets can also be purchased at the Metrodome. All tickets are general admission.

Chaska High School students will also have the opportunity to sign up to ride a fan bus to the State semifinal football game. Forms and information about the fan bus can be found in the Athletics Office.

Community members are invited to take a fan bus to the Metrodome to cheer on the Hawks this Saturday! Want to go to the game? The District's contracted bus company, Positive Connections, will run a Fan Bus for parents or community members. Pick-up is in the Chaska Middle School West parking lot at 4:30 pm Saturday. Cost is \$5.00 per person. (This does not include the cost of the game ticket which would be purchased at the Metrodome upon arrival.)
