## ENGLER BOULEVARD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

Construction work began on Engler Boulevard (CSAH 10) this week and is anticipated to be completed by the end of August. The work scheduled to occur in 2013 will consist of storm sewer installation, roadway widening, reconstruction, concrete medians, along with pavement surfacing improvements. In order to perform the work, the project has been broken into individual phases. During these phases of construction, traffic will be shifted sequentially as each stage of the project is completed.

### Phase 1 Traffic Changes

There will be changes to eastbound and westbound traffic along Engler Boulevard throughout the duration of the project. Phase 1 involves reconstructing the eastbound lane along Engler Boulevard, and installing new concrete medians, along with new concrete curb and gutter. In order to complete the work, the Contractor will be moving eastbound and westbound traffic to the north side of Engler Boulevard. The temporary signal located at the Clover Ridge Drive intersection will be modified to accommodate traffic during all phases of construction. Traffic will be maintained for Clover Ridge, as well as eastbound and westbound Engler Boulevard during construction.



Construction work scheduled for Phase 1 is anticipated to be completed by the end of May. The newly constructed eastbound lanes will provide for two through lanes, as well as turn lanes at West Creek Lane and Clover Ridge Drive once final construction has been completed. As construction proceeds we will be updating the City website for further project phasing.
