DECISION RESOURCES COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS DISCUSSION POSTPONED

Due to the inclement weather experienced on Monday, March 4th, the regular City Council meeting was cancelled. The main item on the agenda for the night was discussion of the Decision Resources Community Survey results.

Every few years the City of Chaska completes a community survey to obtain resident input regarding the quality of life in the community and the perception of City services provided. This data is then used to help us look at how we can improve various services and identify any gaps in services or projects that residents might like to see in the community.



Decision Resources was scheduled to give their presentation to the Council on Monday night. With the cancellation of the Council meeting, the presentation is being rescheduled to the April 15, 2013 meeting. As more details regarding the meeting and presentation are confirmed, the public will continue to be informed. Ultimately, the survey results will be placed on the City website and into several community news articles. The City looks forward to sharing this information with its residents!
