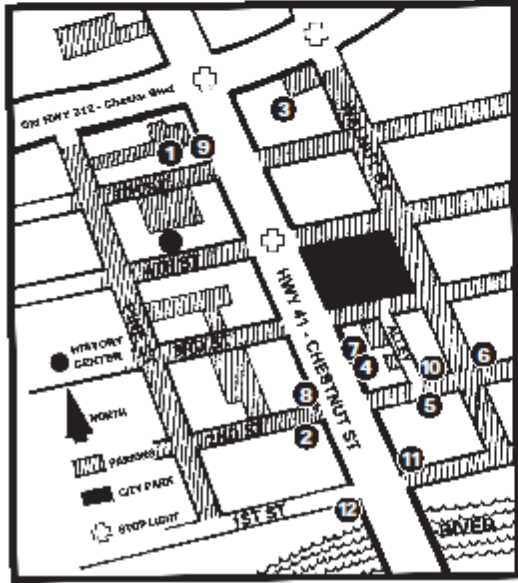

## JUNE 20<sup>TH</sup> TRIVIA WITH A POLITICAL ASSOCIATION



It was on this date in 1983 that the Supreme Court ruled that employers must treat male and female workers equally in providing health benefits for their spouses.

One of the government's most wanted criminals, Benjamin "Bugsy" Siegel, was murdered in Beverly Hills, CA on June 20, 1947 at the age of 41 at the order of mob associates allegedly due to arguments over the cost overruns on the construction of the Flamingo Hotel in Las Vegas. Originally budgeted at \$1.5 million, the building project soon proved to be a problem as construction costs soared to more than \$6 million. It was discovered that many of the overruns were attributable to Siegel's theft and mismanagement That will make you stick to the budget!



In 1963, the famous "hotline" between the U.S. and the Soviet Union is ordered in response to the Cuban missile crisis. It was originally a pair of teletypewriters, which was replaced with an actual phone in the mid-70s.
