COUNCIL APPROVES SECOND DATA CENTER

At the Monday, January 28th meeting of the Chaska City Council, approval was given to the final site and building plans for a second data center to be built in the West Creek Corporate Center. The West Creek Corporate Center was developed just over a year and a half ago. The first building was United Health Group's 250,000 sq ft data center. Stream Data is the company building the first phase of a 115,000 sq ft facility to be located directly west of United Health Group. Additionally, they received preliminary site plan approval for a second phase of development to include a second data center approximately 80,000 sq ft in size. It is expected that the development will move forward with construction in the spring, with completion slated within the next 12 months. The City of Chaska would like to welcome Stream Data to the community!

COUNCIL APPROVES CREEK'S RUN TOWNHOMES

Final site and building plans were approved by the City Council for Phase I of Creek's Run Townhomes located on a portion of the old Chaska Building Center property north of Sun Lake Woods Apartments and running along Yellow Brick Road. The project is being built by Everwood Development and will be just under 100 rental townhomes. The first phase will include just under 50 rental units. Construction is expected to start this spring, with completion by the end of the year. The property is part of the overall Chaska Building Center redevelopment site.

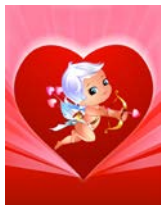
