

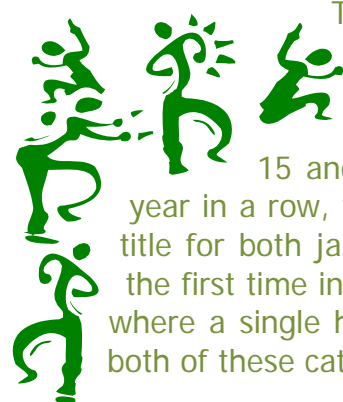

CONGRATULATIONS CHS DANCE TEAM



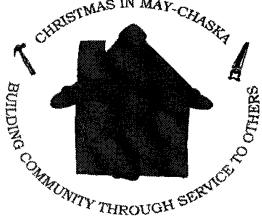

For the second year in a row, the Chaska Girls Dance Team won the State title for both jazz/funk and high kick competitions. This is the first time in the history of the State Dance Competitions where a single high school has taken back to back years in both of these categories.
