

**NEIGHBORHOOD PARK MEETING

Dear Harvest West Resident,

You are receiving this letter because you live near a future neighborhood park that has been planned in the Harvest West development. Chaska Parks and Recreation, along with Public Works staff, will be holding an informational meeting at the park entrance, off Vista View Dr., Tuesday, June 14th at 5:30 p.m. If we need to cancel this meeting due to severe weather, Wednesday, June 22nd, 5:30 p.m. will be the backup date.

At this first meeting, we will cover the below items.

- Overall site conditions
- Proposed location of park amenities and trails
- Project timeline and future meetings

Once we identify the location of park amenities and trails, we will coordinate a future meeting to share a concept of the park plan and gather feedback. Neighborhood parks are generally intended to serve residents who live within a ½ mile radius and are accessed via walking or biking. Neighborhood parks typically include a playground structure, open field play area, and based on the park size, a couple other amenities.
