Submit a Proposal to Name Chaska's Newest Neighborhood Park

Chaska Parks and Recreation invites you to help name the City's newest neighborhood park located in the Harvest West development of SW Chaska. The deadline for submitting naming proposals is *Wednesday, September 7th at 12:00 noon*.

How It Works

1. Complete a Park Naming Proposal Form and turn it in to the Chaska Parks and Recreation office located at 1661 Park Ridge Dr. or email it to parksandrec@chaskamn.com
2. Parks and Recreation staff review the proposals to ensure they are complete.
3. The Chaska Parks and Recreation Commission reviews the completed proposals and makes their recommendation to the Chaska City Council.
4. Chaska City Council receives the recommendation from the Parks and Recreation Commission and makes the final decision/approval.

What Types of Names Will Be Considered?

Priority in naming parks shall be given to geographic features/locations or historic significance unique to Chaska ahead of naming after specific individuals. Please refer to the City of Chaska's Park Naming Policy for a full description.
