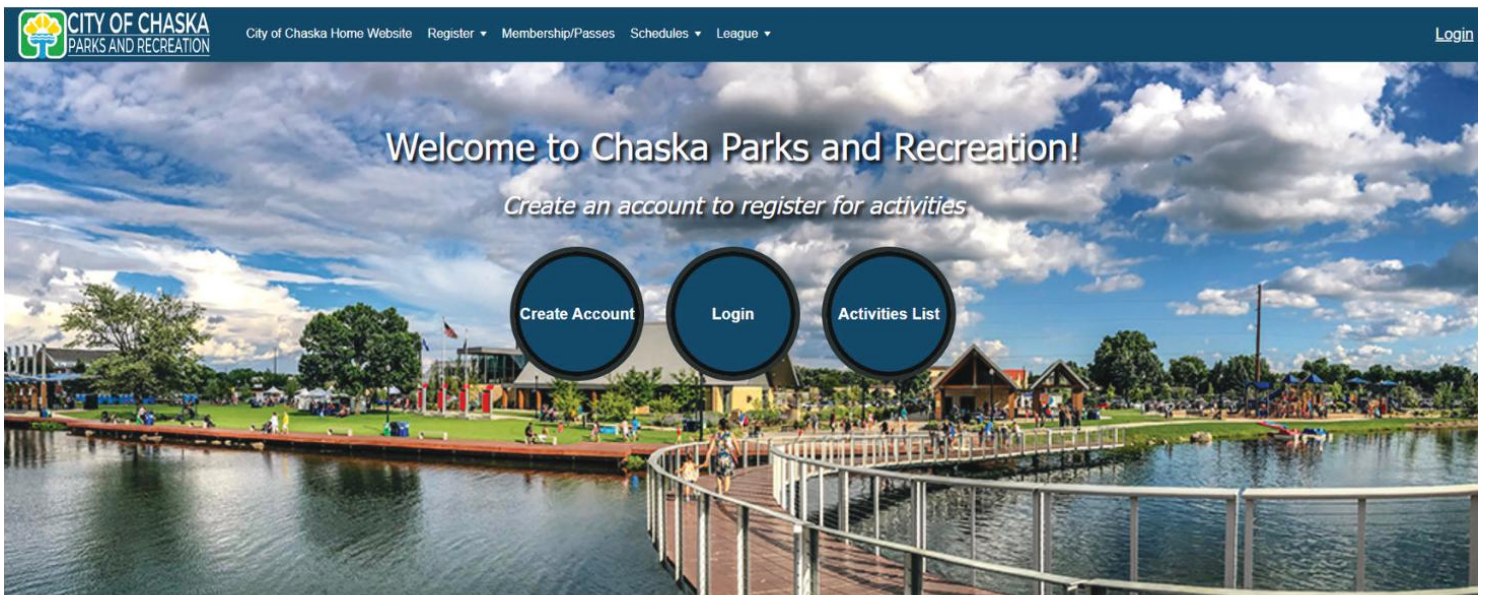

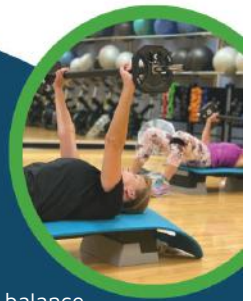

# ICE ARENA OFFERINGS

<b><i>Open Skate</i></b>	Open Skate is open to CCC Members and Non-Members. Open skate sessions vary in length between 60 minutes to two hours. Rental skates are available for \$7 Standard; \$5 Chaska/Carver Resident in sizes 8 junior to adult size 13 in figure skates and hockey skates. A limited number of helmets are available for use but are not required for open skate sessions. Skate training aids/walkers are permitted during open skate sessions but patrons are to provide their own. Use of hockey sticks/pucks are not allowed during open skate sessions.
<b><i>Skate Lessons</i></b>	In partnership with the Chaska Skate School, the CCC offers skate lessons utilizing the Learn to Skate USA curriculum. Skate lesson sessions are 30 minutes in length and 7-10 weeks in length (length varies based on time of year).
<b><i>Adult Open Skate &amp; Adult Open Hockey</i></b>	Adult open skate is designed for participants age 18 & older. Adult open hockey is a recreational hockey opportunity to participants age 18 & older to play pick up hockey. No checking or abusive play is allowed.
<b><i>Developmental Figure Skating</i></b>	Developmental figure skating is time for skaters looking to enhance their figure skating routines and skills. Jumps, spins, and program practice is allowed. This time is set aside for figure skating work only. Coaches/parents must pay the Developmental Ice fee or be CCC members.
<b><i>Developmental Youth Hockey</i></b>	Developmental youth hockey sessions is ice time set aside for participants under the age of 18 to develop their hockey skills. Full equipment including helmet and mouth guard is required. A parent or coach must pay daily admission and wear helmet (while on ice with skaters.)
<b><i>Ice Rentals</i></b>	Interested in gathering a group for a hockey practice, group visit, birthday party, or private ice session? Visit our website for the latest available for rent schedule. Ice rental costs varies by time of year and time of day.
<b><i>Skate Sharpening</i></b>	The CCC offers figure and hockey skate sharpening. A secure drop box is located inside the Arena 1 lobby to allow patrons to drop skates off to be sharpened. All skates are sharpened within 24 hours. Patrons should attach a tag with their name and phone number to skates to be sharpened. Cost is \$7 Standard; \$5 Chaska/Carver Residents.

## Snow Plow Sam Program

### Snowplow Sam 1

For ages 4-7, beginner or skaters with very little experience wishing to learn how to skate. Focusing on fun, comfort and movement on ice with games, songs, and toys. Student attends class without parent on ice. Skaters progress from one level to the next by mastering required elements.

### Snow Plow Sam 2

For ages 4 and up, who have completed Sam 1 or can move forward across the ice on their own.

### Snow Plow Sam 3

For ages 4 and up, who have completed Sam 2 or can skate forward and backward.

### Snow Plow Sam 4

For ages 4 and up, who have completed Sam 3 or can skate.

## Figure Skating

### Learn to Jump and Spin! (Ages 6+)

For skaters who have passed Advanced LTS and interested in figure skating. Classes will include skating skills.

### Private Lessons

Private lessons are a great way to hone in on skills you need more help with: one-on-one with one of our professional Instructors provides this! Private lessons are available for both recreational and competitive skaters, youth and adults. Or, take a lesson with a friend: Semi-private lessons are an affordable way to take advantage of the benefits of private lessons. ## Basic Skills - Learn to Skate (LTS)

Progressive classes for ages 4 and up who have already passed Sam 4 or can already skate forward, stop, glide on one foot and skate backwards. Skaters will learn a variety of basic skating skills necessary for all types of skating, including recreational, figure skating and hockey. These levels focus on proper technique, safety and introduce fundamental moves: forward skating, backward skating, stops, edges, crossovers and turns.

### Beginner LTS

For ages 8-13, beginner or skaters with very little experience wishing to learn how to skate. Skaters progress from one level to the next by mastering required elements.

### Intermediate LTS

Primary focus to develop forward skating, stops, backward skating, build strength and balancing on one foot to prepare for crossovers.

### Advanced 1 LTS

Primary focus to develop forward crossovers, introduce backward crossovers and two foot turns.

### Advanced 2 LTS

Primary focus to develop backward skating and back crossovers, increase speed and power, introduce one foot turns.

## Hockey Curriculum

### Hockey Skills Beginner (ages 4+)

For skaters who have passed Snowplow Sam 3, Beginner LTS or can skate forward and backward. Skaters will learn how to maneuver faster and be more agile on the ice. Learn basic backward skating moves and 2-foot turns.

### Hockey Skills Intermediate & Advanced (ages 5+)

For skaters who have passed Beginner Hockey, Intermediate LTS or can skate forward & backward proficiently, stop, and glide forward on one foot.

*Necessary equipment-Hockey skates, certified hockey helmet (ice approved), hockey stick and hockey gloves (optional).*

# AQUATICS OFFERINGS



## **Swim Lessons**

At the Chaska Community Center, we offer American Red Cross swimming lessons led by our encouraging, caring, and dedicated instructors. Our goal is to help patrons develop swimming and water safety skills in a fun and positive environment.

### **Summer swim lessons registration**

**May 11th at 10:00 am: Open to members and residents**

## **Lap Swim and Deep-Water Exercise**

Lap Swim is designed for individuals swimming for exercise. Participants may swim laps, aqua jog, or engage in deep-water exercises. Equipment such as water weights, noodles, fins, and kickboards are available. Swimmers should be prepared to share lanes.

## **Open Swim**

Open Swim is a designated pool time for children and families. It typically includes access to both pools (without lane lines), the yellow water slide, a diving platform, and a rope swing.

## **Tot Time Swim**

Tot Time Swim is a wonderful opportunity to introduce little ones to the water in a setting designed specifically for children under 6 and their guardians. Tot Time is held in the Kiddie pool and includes play features and a water slide, see guidelines below.

- A parent/guardian must be in the water and within arm's reach of their child at all times.
- Swimming suits are required for all swimmers.
- All non-toilet-trained children must wear swim diapers with a plastic liner.

## **Hot Spa/Dry Sauna/Steam Room**

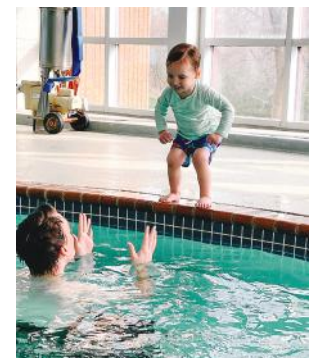
All guests using the spa must shower off before entering the water. The Dry Sauna and Wet Steam Room are for ages 15 and up. The hot spa is for ages 18 and up.

## Q & A

### How do I try curling?

A great way to get involved with curling would be a learn to curl class. These two hour classes cover rules, etiquette, sweeping, and on-ice practice of proper delivery and sweeping techniques. We ask that those new to the game participate in a learn to curl class before using the ice or playing in leagues.

### Is this like bowling, can we rent a sheet of ice?

Curling ice and equipment is very specialized and expensive. Damage to the ice, hacks, and rocks can and does happen when inexperienced curlers step on the ice. On top of that, we don't want people going out on the ice and getting hurt. We ask that people with no curling experience participate in a learn to curl class or a group lesson before using our practice ice. It will make for a much more enjoyable experience.

### The leagues look fun; how do I get involved?

The spring and summer leagues are a great time to get involved in curling. We are one of only a few facilities in the country that offer year-round ice. Spring and summer leagues are 6 weeks long and the cost is cheaper as our memberships are pro-rated. The season is much shorter than the 20-week winter season. We would ask that new curlers participate in a Futures league. Our open leagues will have more experienced curlers looking for more competitive games.

### This looks like a fun activity for my coworkers. Do you offer company parties?

We host corporate team-building curling lessons almost every day. The best times to book are M-F during the early afternoon. Weekends can also be options and available ice time varies by season. We provide a quick lesson on the game, including rules and scoring and then work with you on the ice to get you comfortable sliding, sweeping, and playing a game. Your group will have a great time learning about and playing the game. No curling experience is needed. We have instructors on the ice the entire time to make sure you are having a great time. Catering options are available through the Crooked Pint and meeting space is available in our 20-person lounge or 300-seat Event Center.

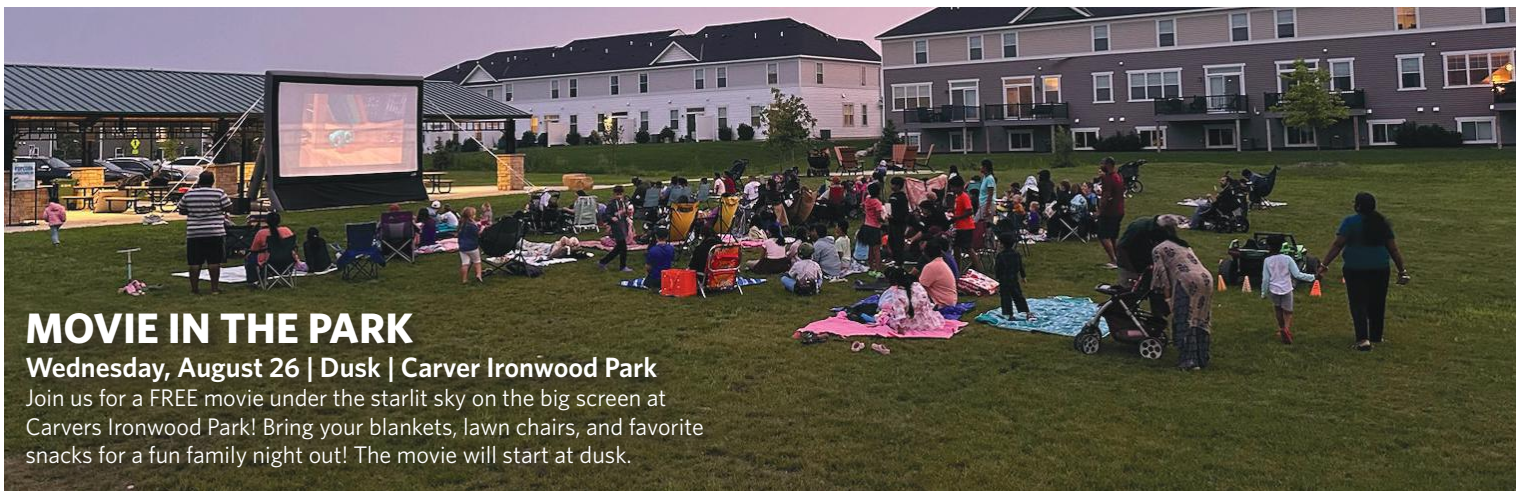

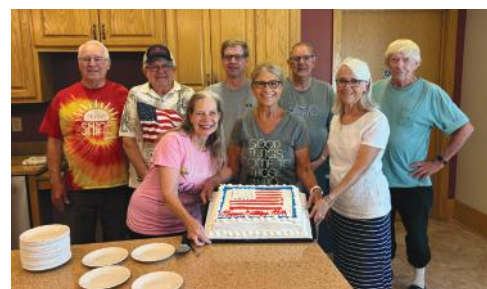
